To ensure fire protection for the residents of Brooke-Alvinston, the Municipality has met with neighbouring municipalities and the County Fire Coordinator and discussed automatic aid coverage of the Inwood area in addition to the current mutual aid program in the County.

Acknowledging the recent resignation of 16 members from Brooke Fire Rescue – Inwood Station, the Municipality of Brooke-Alvinston continues to be protected by 29 Brooke Fire Rescue firefighters and 7 fire apparatus between the Alvinston and Inwood Stations.

All requests for open burns should be forwarded to the municipal office at 519-898-2173 with a requested 3 day notice period.

The Municipality and Brooke Fire Rescue reminds all residents to practice fire safety and to:

- maintain working smoke alarms on every storey of your home and outside all sleeping areas to have as much time to safely escape as possible. Not only do smoke alarms save lives, they are required by law;
- plan and practice a home fire escape plan so everyone in the home knows
 exactly what to do should the smoke alarms sound in an emergency;
- if your home has a fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage, install a carbon monoxide alarm adjacent to each sleeping area.
