- Deferred the request for funding from the Central Lambton Family Health Team to the 2020 budget deliberations
- Requested the Arts & Activity Group to discuss their planned event in August with the Inwood Firemen's Association to avoid any conflicts in scheduling of events
- Supported the Municipality of Chatham-Kent in their resolution for continued provincial support of the Legal Aid system
- Supported the Township of Zorra in their resolution to support the continuation of programs of the Upper Thames River Conservation Authority.
- Approved monies received from the Ontario Cannabis Legalization Fund to be placed in a reserve account
- Approved the purchase of an agenda management system with iCompass
- Directed staff to report on direct and indirect costs associated with the video / audio recording of Council meetings both open and closed;
- Supported the Alvinston Optimist Club with their efforts in applying to the Canada Infrastructure Program – Community, Culture and Recreation Funding Stream for funding for the wooden pavilion (\$88,000) and washrooms (\$190,000).
- Approved the new culvert installation at Lot 7 Concession 7
- Approved the Drain Consideration meeting on the Kelly Drain to begin at 6:45 p.m. on October 24, 2019 and prior to the regular meeting start of 7:00 p.m.
- Approved the request from the property owners of 3243 Elgin Street in Alvinston to place a temporary storage container on the property from October 1-May 1, 2020 while undergoing renovations
