Council Highlights

- Heard presentations from Lambton OPP Inspector Chris Avery and Mike Gorgey of the Lambton Public Health;
- Received and filed the financial report presented by the Clerk Administrator on Inwood Fire Apparatus Bay options;
- Received and filed the report presented by the Clerk Administrator regarding the current non profit status of the Inwood Firemen's Association; legal issues received from the municipal lawyer in regards to the proposed lease from the IFA; and the lease committee's recommendation of the \$30,000 offer to lease the fire hall annually from the IFA;
- Staff were directed to send a letter to the IFA inquiring if they would discuss selling the hall to the Municipality to ensure the fire hall's viability;
- Approved the IFA Turkey Shoot on December 14, 2019;
- Approved road closures for the Arts & Activity Festival scheduled for August 22, 2019 in Alvinston;
- Approved the extension of an existing dwelling at 4839 Hardy Creek Road until the new dwelling is completed;
- Discussed the municipal Official Plan review proposed by the County of Lambton;
- Reviewed the RFP for Grant Writers as submitted;
- Advised staff to proceed with vesting the property municipally known as 3202 Park Street in Inwood;
- Approved the purchase of upgraded water meter reading equipment and software
