- Held a moment of silence for two members of the community who recently passed away: Tanner Redick, a member of Brooke Fire Rescue and Tom Lassaline a former Council member
 - Approved the 2020 Municipal Insurance Renewal presented by representatives of the Frank Cowan Company
 - Supported the Town of Petrolia's resolution requesting that the Lambton Group Police Services Board and Lambton OPP provide a minimum of 3 months' notice in future contract renewals
 - Requested the Province to consider that when transition to the blue box program proceeds to full producer responsibility, the date be April 1, 2024
 - Approved the Cost of Living Allowance for staff be 1.9% in 2020 in accordance with the National Joint Council
 - Approved the mileage rate increase of \$0.565 / km
 - Authorized staff to organize and advertise for the 2020 Large Item Day and Rabies Clinic for April 18, 2020
 - Approved the 2020 Municipal Health & Safety Policy
 - Directed the Chief Building Official of the Municipality to proceed with applicable charges under the Building Code Act for the property municipally known as 3239-3241 River Street in Alvinston
 - Received an update on the findings of the municipal water leak, bridge inspections and proposed improvements to Hilly Road
 - Directed the Public Works Manager to relocate the municipal generator to the municipally owned shed in Inwood and request the IFA to remove their padlock and materials from the small building
 - Formally approved the site plan presented by Roger Buurma
 - Approved the Interim Tax levies By-law; Penalty By-law and Borrowing By-law
 - Approved two tile loan applications for 2020
 - Acknowledged the winning ELMHA teams in the local Silver Stick tournaments
 - Approved the 2020 tree program for the Municipality
