

Municipality of Brooke-Alvinston Council Highlights February 13, 2020

- Approved the Zoning Amendment for 6924 Aberfeldy Line (Cob Roller Farms) from the "Agriculture 1 (A1) Zone" to the "No-Dwelling Agricultural (ND-A) Zone" which would prohibit the construction of future residential dwellings in perpetuity on the farm lot;
- Held the Court of Revision on the Kelly Drain;
- Heard a presentation from Four Counties Transportation Services in regards to potential ridership in Brooke-Alvinston;
- Directed staff to look into funding options for the Municipality to make application to the Judith & Norman Alix Foundation;
- Approved funding to Lambton 4H in the amount of \$250;
- Approved donating outdated fire equipment (bunker gear) to Lambton College;
- Approved Chris Regier Trucking in the amount of \$20.55 / tonne for gravel requirements in 2020;
- Reviewed the 2019 Building Permit Summary;
- Continued discussions on the preliminary 2020 budget;
- Directed staff to obtain material pricing for a new fire hall in Inwood for consideration;
- Directed staff to work with the County Planner and report to Council on new development sites in the Municipality
