- Supported the Township of Mapleton's Resolution: Provincial review of Farm Property Class Tax Rate
- Supported the Township of Armour's Resolution: High speed internet connectivity in rural Ontario
- Authorized the application of larvicide in the Municipality to control the West Nile Virus
- Approved the social service integration proposal for the Alvinston Library
- Acknowledged the PT Fire Chief vacancy (July 31, 2020) and Parks & Recreation Supervisor vacancy (March 2020) and associated posting.
