Firefighter Recruitment Information Guide

Background:

Brooke Fire Rescue (BFR) originated in 2017 after the amalgamation of the Alvinston and Inwood Fire Departments which now serve as the Alvinston and Inwood Stations. BFR protects the Municipality of Brooke-Alvinston including the communities of Alvinston and Inwood. Firefighters in Brooke-Alvinston are volunteer/paid on call and respond to a variety of emergency incidents including fires, motor vehicle collisions and medical calls.

Brooke Fire Rescue Facts:

- Respond to 40-50 responses per year
- Firefighters train a minimum of twice month
- 5 apparatus (fire trucks)
 - 1 Rescues
 - 1 Pumpers
 - 2 Tankers
 - 1 Pickup
 - 1 Station in Alvinston

We Need:

- Dedicated, honest and positive individuals who have an interest in protecting their community and would like to join the Brooke Fire Rescue team and become a Probationary Firefighter.

We Offer:

- Paid training
- Paid calls
- A chance to join a Proud and Professional Fire Service
- An opportunity to serve the residents of Brooke-Alvinston
- Individually issued bunker gear, helmet, gloves, boots, SCBA mask and other Personal Protective Equipment as needed.
- VFIS Insurance coverage

We Require:

- 18 years and older (16 years and older for Student Firefighter)
- First Aid/CPR/First Responder training - within 1 year of recruitment
- DZ Licence - within 1 year of recruitment
- An MTO medical from your physician - due upon recruitment offer
- A Police Vulnerable Sector Check - due upon recruitment offer
- A satisfactory MTO driver's abstract - due upon recruitment offer
- Commitment to attend and complete all NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 & 2 and NFPA 1072 Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations level certification courses from a recognized training provider, Regional Training Centre or through Brooke Fire Rescue within the agreed upon timeline.
- To live or work in Brooke-Alvinston or within a reasonable distance
- A commitment to regularly attend scheduled training and respond to calls.

Application Process:

- Application forms can be picked up at the Brooke-Alvinston Municipal Office at 3236 River Street, Alvinston between 8:30 - 4:30 on regular business days or by emailing firechief@brookealvinston.com.
- Completed applications along with a current resume may be dropped off or submitted in the same manner as above.
- When positions are available you may be contacted for an interview.
