Susan is the owner of two businesses in Sarnia: The Bookkeeper and Poppies gift shop in Bluewater Health. Susan is a leader in promoting 2SLGBTQI+ inclusiveness in our community. Susan organizes and hosts a Lambton Literacy fundraiser which brings renowned writers to speak with proceeds to Lambton Literacy. Susan has been on the Mayors Honor list in 2014 and again recognized in 2016 for her leadership with being a board member at the Lawrence House.

Marylin Gifford (Sarnia) – Marylin's tireless work to bring awareness to the doctor shortage within Lambton County and across Canada. Marylin collected thousands of signatures to petition for more medical residency placements for Sarnia and Lambton County. Marylin has been recognized and supported by Mayor Mike Bradley and made national news with JP Tasker of CBC news.

Jeannette Douglas (Alvinston) – Jeannette can be found supporting and making her community better, with her strong voice and serving those most vulnerable in her community. Jeannette served a term on municipal council and has planned Canada Day events ensuring everyone in the community enjoys!

Parents for Parks (Petrolia) – Almost 5 years ago, Laurel Pickel-Kittmer, Erin Miller Hawryluk, Emily Bright, Emily Denham Weed, from Petrolia noticed that Petrolia could use an accessible playground at Greenwood Park. They saw a need and took on this major challenge, displaying leadership and action-oriented focus. The group ran many fundraisers and sought out donations from everywhere, they set up a fund with the SCF and within 2 years had enough funding to get the project started. On September 27, 2022, the parked opened and has played a major positive impact for the community. The Parents are not done yet.... they now have their site set on a pavilion for shelter and BBQ's.
