And that the Municipality provide for 2 accessible portable washrooms;

And that one (1) fire truck be parked on the route at the discretion of the Fire Chief for first aid purposes;

And that a copy of the clubs insurance naming the municipality as additionally insured be provided prior to the event. Councillor Craig Sanders seconded the motion.
